

CATCH UP FUNDING PLAN SUMMARY

Following the lengthy lockdown period, the government recognised that many children will have fallen behind their expected levels in English and maths. As part of a recovery programme, they have given £80 per pupil (Rec to Y6) to help with catch up activities and support.

This is a relatively small amount of money for a whole school and it has been necessary to prioritise where exactly this funding needs to be spent.

The majority of the funding will be used for reading Intervention in lower KS2 Juniors. EYFS and KS1 will concentrate heavily on phonics and we already have plans and support in place for this.

UKS2 will have extra HLTA support focusing on basic skills predominantly in English.

The impact for all of the actions below will be that every child within the identified intervention groups make progress from their September starting points.
